Burnaby Summer Session offers a limited number of TUITION FREE academic courses for eligible students. Your child is eligible if they:

- are a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee under 19 (born after June 30, 1990)
- Have a BC Personal Education Number (PEN)

Note: Eligible students can only register once in a tuition free academic course.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

(One tuition free course per eligible student)

English as a Second Language

These courses provide students at the elementary level with the opportunity for English language improvement with a focus on speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.

Programs are open to students who have completed first year primary to those who have completed Grade 7. Grade 7 students may register for either the Elementary ESL Program or Secondary ESL Program.

Skill Development Programs

These courses provide your elementary-aged child with the opportunity to practice and review Language Arts and Mathematics foundation skills in individual and group settings.

- Primary Skill Development – for students who have completed Grades 1 - 3.
- Intermediate Skill Development – for students who have completed Grades 4 - 6.

Transition Programs

These courses will help students who are going into Grades 1, 4 or 8 by introducing them to some of the required skills and learning strategies as well as classroom expectations for the next grade level.

Ready! Set! Go! Going Into Grade 1

Students who have successfully completed Kindergarten can get ready for Grade 1 with a hands-on, minds-on introduction to the Grade one program. Students will review alphabet and letter sounds plus concentrate on counting and addition/subtraction skills.

Ready! Set! Go! Going Into Grade 4

This course will begin to prepare the outgoing primary students (Grade 3) for the intermediate (Grade 4) classroom. Basic reading, writing, math and organizational skills/expectations will be explored at a beginning intermediate level.

Ready! Set! Go! Going Into Grade 4 – French Immersion (Gr. 4)

This course prepares French immersion students who are starting grade 4 in the fall. Students will be offered skill practice and strategies to be successful in Gr. 4.

Grade 8 Transition

This course is for students that have successfully completed grade 7 and would like exposure to life at the secondary level. An introduction to Mathematics 8, English 8 and expectations and behaviours required for success in Grade 8.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

(One tuition free course per eligible student)

Essay and Report Writing (Gr. 4-7)

Learn an easy to follow formula to help communicate ideas and focus thoughts while adding style and meaning to your writing. Students will practice fundamental skills of paragraph organization, topic development, effective conclusions, and revision/editing skills.

Fun in the Sun With Reading (Gr. 1-4)

Develop an appreciation for the enjoyment of literature, increase confidence with the printed word and get a jumpstart for September. The development of literacy, critical thinking and higher level thinking skills will be stressed while participating in a variety of literary experiences.

Math Workshop

Give those basic math skills a boost! Through a selection of hands-on experiences, games and direct teaching, children will reinforce basic math skills and concepts that will strengthen their abilities to solve problems with accuracy and confidence.

- Primary Math Workshop - Gr. 2-3
- Intermediate Math Workshop - Gr. 4-7

Reading Power! Non-Fiction for Primary Students (Gr. 1-3)

This course will provide engaging and intensive instruction in reading non-fiction. Students will learn and practice a variety of research-based strategies to improve their ability to read and understand non-fiction text. This program will provide a range of interactive experiences designed to inspire confidence and strong non-fiction reading skills.

Reading Power! Non-Fiction for Intermediate Students (Gr. 4-7)

This course will provide engaging and intensive instruction in reading non-fiction. Students will learn and practice a variety of research-based strategies to improve their ability to read and understand non-fiction text. This program will provide a range of interactive experiences designed to inspire confidence and strong non-fiction reading skills.

Successful Tools and Strategies For Reading (Gr. 2-3)

One of the keys to success in school is reading comprehension. In this course students will use SMART reading tools and strategies to learn and practise the thinking process (predicting, questioning and connecting) that is essential for strong comprehension.

Surprising Science (Gr. 2-7)

Students in both the primary and intermediate programs will have fun while learning scientific principles and methods through active hands-on experimentation.

Writer's Workshop

Does your child have a burning desire to be an author? Primary students will work together to build ideas, frame their thinking and use writing to communicate their thinking in a powerful way. Intermediate students will be taken through the steps of the writing process in order to further develop their skills in drafting, editing, revising, and critiquing their writing.

Art & Literature (Gr. 2-5)

Building Leaders for Tomorrow (Gr. 4-7)

Do you see your child as a developing leader? This newly designed course will give your child the opportunity to participate in team building and leadership activities. Instructors trained in leadership and leaders in the community will be invited to help facilitate this course. The goal of the course is to finish with a culminating activity that displays the students' newly acquired strengths in leadership.

Drama (Gr. 1-7)

Through drama and games, improvisation and skill-based exercises, this course offers physical and vocal dramatic training for your child and culminates with a short, fun, original performance created by the students and instructor.

Learning with Laughter (Gr. 1-7)

Sign up for this full-course buffet of learning and laughter! Each day, your child will rotate with kids in their age group through three activities: science, arts and gym. Instruction in science concepts and art techniques will be reinforced by giving students time each day to explore and experiment. They will build outrageous structures, conduct weird science experiments, explore the artwork of unusual artists and get a healthy workout with sports and games.

Yoga for Kids (Gr. 2-5)

Yoga is a fun way to keep the body healthy, quiet the mind and calm down. This course will use games, drama and art to bring the benefits of yoga to kids.
